DOCTOR'S OFFICE

HOSPITAL

If you are hospitalized for any reason, you can talk to your care team about vaccines before discharge.



LOCAL HEALTH CENTER

Federally funded health centers offer many health services, including vaccinations, regardless of insurance status.



PHARMACIES/RETAIL CHAINS

Pharmacies offer most vaccines for adults. Call ahead to make sure the pharmacy has the vaccines you need and find out how much you need to pay.



LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT

State and local health departments are great resources to find out where you can get vaccinated and learn more about about free and low-cost vaccines.



GROCERY STORES

Like pharmacies, many retail grocers offer a variety of the vaccines you need.
